Guidelines for streaming of S.4 students

- Students will be streamed according to their choices of elective subjects.
- Class size of electives will be limited to 32.
 A small number of places will be allocated at school's own discretion.
- Priority will be given to students who have a higher yearly order of merit. (the yearly order of merit is based on the sum of 1/3 of the average mark of the Half-yearly Exam and 2/3 of the average mark of the Final exam).

Students opting for BAFS have to select the module BAFS-A (Accounting) or BAFS-B (Business). Students may also select both modules. School will allocate only one of the two groups for the student.

Application forms for changing electives and classes will be available at school office by 1 September 2014. Deadline for handing in the application forms will be on 12 September 2014. Applications after the deadline will not be entertained.






